B: When you get to the supermarket, take the second left. You'll pass a cinema and the Chinese restaurant is next to the cinema on your right.

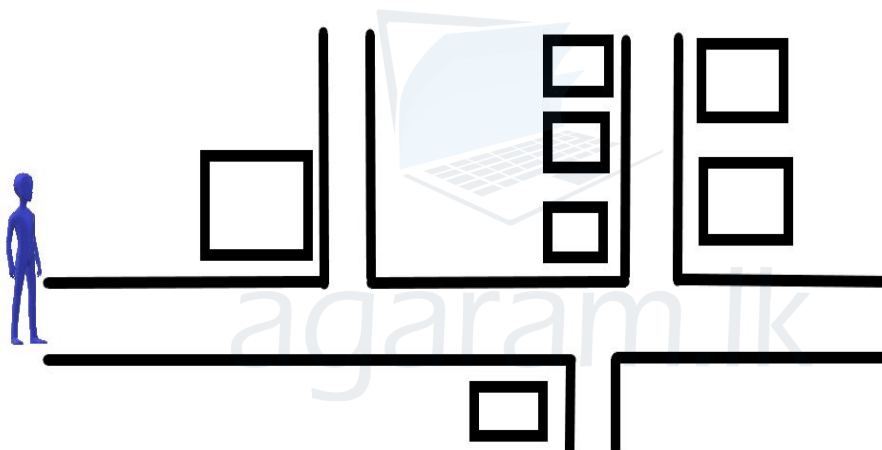
B: Thank you very much.

A: How far is it from here?

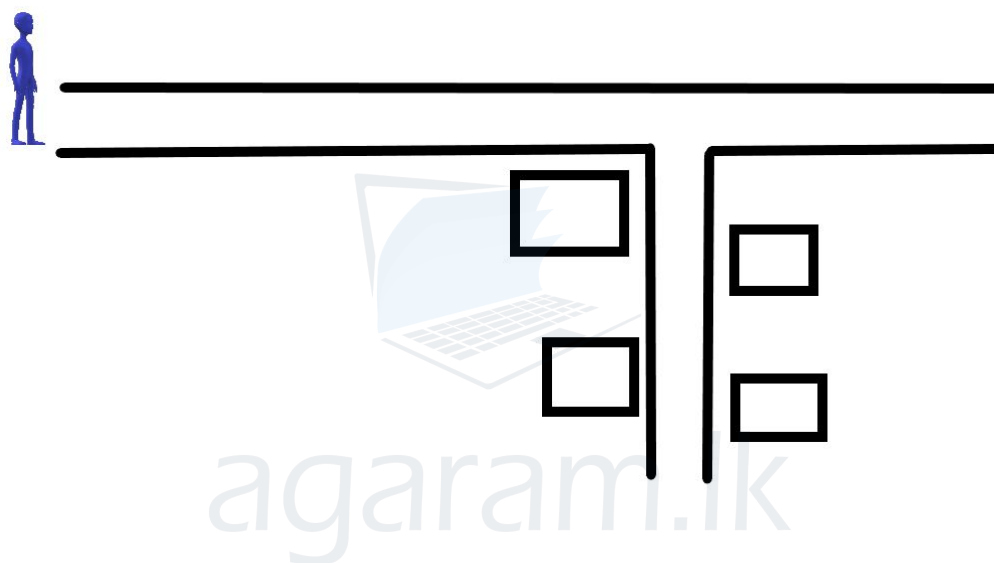
B: It's about one kilometer.

Subject :- Get well letter to the student - Nimal


Dear student Nimal,
